

The top textual variants of the Gospels

To get under the top-five or top-twenty,

1. there must be some theological implication.
2. there must be serious difficulties in evaluating the evidence.
3. there must be the "je ne sais quoi", some teasing peculiarity, something that thrills.
4. the man on the street should say: "Hey, yes, that's interesting!"

1. The top five

These are my personal favorites. This list is very subjective, of course.

1. Lk 23:34 "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do."
2. Lk 22:43-44 "Then an angel from heaven appeared"
3. Lk 9:55-56 "You know not what manner of spirit you are of."
4. Mt 27:16 Jesus Barabbas
5. Mt 27:49 The piercing

2. The top 20

This is in my opinion the most objective list. The entries arose quite naturally.
